

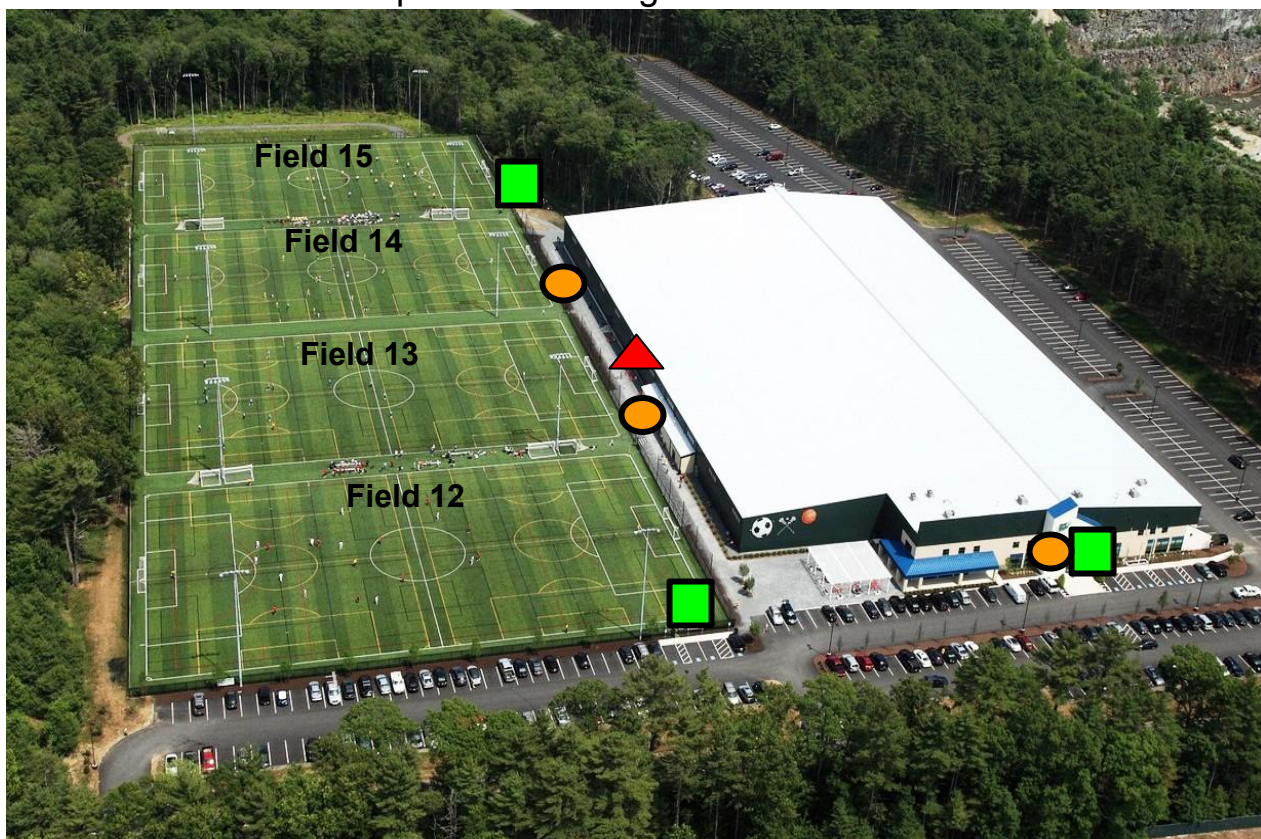
COVID-19 Reopening Phase 3

Revised 3/4/2021


Fore Kicks facilities are now re-opening within Phase 3 restrictions. Our indoor and outdoor fields and courts are available for rental & clinics with certain restrictions and social distancing depending on the sport and age levels. Please call our facilities for further information.


The following guidelines are in place to ensure a safe and enjoyable environment for all patrons and staff at Fore Kicks. They will be strictly enforced. Failure to do so can result in removal from premises or cancellation of rental agreement.

1. INDOOR SPECTATORS are required to stay in their cars or drop off and pick up their participants. OUTDOOR SPECTATORS may stand socially distanced along access road adjacent to fields to view games with masks on.
2. [LIVEBARN](#) viewing available remotely on all INDOOR and OUTDOOR fields/courts.
3. BATHROOMS are for Fore Kicks indoor and outdoor participants only and are limited to 2 people at a time.
4. All TRASH must be removed from the area. Trash in/Trash out.
5. WATER fountains (inside) are off until further notice.
6. BENCHES have been removed from fields.
7. STATE guidelines regarding social distancing must be adhered to including no groups on fields or courts larger than 25 people with 20 feet separation between groups
8. FACE MASKS required at all times for ages 5 years and up, **even when active on court/field**, including entry and exit from the building, bathroom visits, etc.
9. SANITIZER STATIONS are available at entry to building and fields.
10. WHEN ACTIVITY IS OVER, players must leave building immediately. No gathering around inside or outside. Parents can pick-up outside front door
11. ENTRY and EXIT points are designated below.
